The successful candidate will be selected based on the following criteria:

- The candidate must be a current resident, have ties to, or own or operate a business in Barberton.

- Previous and proven Board level experience in a similar organization or professional setting.

Term starts on January 1, 2018 and is for 3 years, board members can serve up to 3 consecutive terms. The Board meets at least quarterly (February, May, August, November) on the third Thursday of the month at 5:00 p.m., and also holds an annual meeting in January. Each board member will also be required to serve on at least 3 Foundation committees. Descriptions and meeting times for committees vary and will involve weeknights and occasional weekends.

The vision of BCF is to strengthen the Barberton Community for current and future generations by providing leadership, fostering collaboration, and creating a legacy of giving to do good. BCF has provided over \$81 million dollars in grants and scholarship to the community. We focus on educational excellence, economic development, social service empowerment and community image enhancement.
